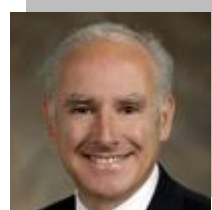

## Practicum



The practicum prepares students for employment in the field of public health. It is a structured and supervised professional experience for which students receive academic credit. Students are required to complete at least 150 hours of hands-on practical experience at an organization, institution or program that is engaged in health promotion, health policy development, the prevention of disease,

health service delivery or research in a global context. Student placement is based on his/her career interests.

## Tuition, fees and scholarships

For international students tuition and fees for the full academic year is approximately \$US 10,000\*. This amount includes tuition, fees for University services and obligatory health insurance. Additional costs will include living expenses such as the cost of dormitories or rent, food and entertainment. For information on scholarships please refer to our website.



## Accommodation

All international students who are enrolled in a full-time program of study are eligible to live in the campus dormitories alongside other international and Israeli students. The University of Haifa offers apartments of three or six single rooms, each with its own bathroom, and a shared kitchen and living space. The dormitories provide many facilities for student's use. # Admission requirements

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited university
- A minimum GPA of 3.0, 80% or equivalent
- Copy of diploma and official transcript
- General GRE scores taken within the last five years OR TOEFL scores (if native language is not English or candidates have not previously studied at an institution of higher education where the language of instruction is English).
- At least two letters of recommendation from academic and/or professional sources
- Personal Statement (500-750 words)
- CV/Résumé
- Copy of valid passport & six passport-sized photos
