

Insurance Registration Information

The University of Haifa International School requires that all students be covered by an Israeli health insurance company for the duration of their studies. The International School works with the Harel-Yedidim Insurance Company, which provides medical services through Clalit Medical Services. Health insurance is included in the tuition fee for all full-time students studying in the International School.

The health insurance provided by Harel-Yedidim does not cover students above the age of 65 or any pre-existing conditions. Therefore, if you do not qualify for the Harel-Yedidim health insurance for either of these reasons, the University of Haifa requires that you be covered by insurance from your home country that will be valid for treatment in Israel.

The International School has arranged for the health insurance to cover you in Israel, for two days before the date the program begins and to continue for one day after the program ends. If you will be arriving to Israel earlier or staying later and you would like to have health insurance for this additional period of time, you must make the arrangements directly with the health insurance company. The health insurance covers all injuries or illnesses that occur while you are in Israel. The health insurance policy excludes: pre-existing medical condition, mental problems, pregnancy and birth coverage and dental treatment. (The full and binding terms of the policy are those who appear in the policy)

Please note students will be covered starting two days before the beginning of their program, and coverage will end one day after the program is completed.

Please notice: You will have to inform the Harel insurance company and/or the international school registration office, if you have any change in your medical condition that occurred during the period between the day you signed on the health declaration and the beginning of the insurance policy. The policy will not cover any pre-existing medical condition, or any new medical condition that occurs during the period between the date you signed on the health declaration and the beginning of the insurance policy.
