Dear Student,

Welcome to University of Haifa Dormitories.

There are three on-campus dormitory complexes are open to reservation for international graduate students*:

Prior to your arrival on October 28th, 2024, you are required to pay the first installment that includes the deposit in the amount of \$250 USD (the deposit payment for the couple apartment is \$500), and the first 1.5 month's payment, according to the dormitory chosen (until November 30th):

- \$865 Federman Single
- \$775 Federman Double
- \$977.5 Talia
- \$1,820 Talia Couples
- \$1,610 Shikma Couples





If you cancel your participation in the program at least **one month before the program starts**, you will be entitled to receive a full refund of the monthly fee, excluding the \$250/\$500 deposit.

According to the contract, the deposit will be refund after the student leaves the dormitory.

PLEASE NOTE!

The deadline for the deposit and first month's payment is due by <u>July 31th, 2024</u> If you do not pay your deposit and first month's rent by <u>July 31th, 2024</u> The dormitories will not reserve a dorm room.

The payment is made directly to the dorms office, not the International School, please refer to payment methods below.

Methods of Payment:

You can pay via Cash or Credit Card or Bank Transfer payments:

Cash: In person only! Please bring the exact amount as we cannot guarantee that the change will be available.

If you pay by bank transfer:

- 1. Please send a copy of your receipt from the transaction to <u>doster@univ.haifa.ac.il</u>
- 2. Please note that there are transfer fees charged by your bank or the receiving bank, so be sure to transfer enough funds to cover your fees owed to the University of Haifa and any additional fees. If we do not receive the total amount due to transaction fees, you will be asked to pay the difference.
- 3. Please note that it takes several business days for this payment to be processed

Credit Card: by the following link: Credit card Payment (for students)

You can pay the entire amount via credit card or up to 10 payments- <u>only at the office</u>; however, it is the responsibility of the student to verify that he/she has the proper credit limit to pay the full amount in advance.





While in Israel, it will be possible to make monthly payments via direct automatic debit of an Israeli bank account. For that purpose, the student will need to open an Israeli bank account and issue an active standing order for monthly payment of the dormitories fees.
