

- **Grant Proposal Preparation (2 credits), 286.4660, Semester B- Mondays 14-16, Dr. Shirra Freeman:** The course will provide a hands-on approach funding research projects and evidence-informed interventions. projects. The structure and requirements of major public funding programs in Europe and North America as well as philanthropic foundations will be presented. Students will be guided through the process of searching and selecting the appropriate programs and Requests for Proposals (RFPs), developing partnerships and consortia, and preparing proposals. All stages of proposal preparation including scientific excellence, expected outcomes, impact, and budgets will be analyzed in detail.
