Course Registration Procedure	With only a few exceptions, exchange students register online via the "Campus Management" system. Information on how registration works is provided during orientation days, along with the necessary log in data.  NOTE: Only those students that have met our deadlines and have sent all requested

	forms (as indicated in "Distributed Campus") will receive their log-in data in time. Since online registration starts only on the first day of term, i.e. 1 October/1 April, all Learning Agreements signed previously by our institution are to be regarded as preliminary.

Living Costs	While Erasmus students do not pay study or registration fees, they are required to pay social fees and the public transport ticket ("Semesterticket"), which is valid for one term. This payment must be made before or during the personal enrolment. Exemption from the public transport ticket is not possible.
	Furthermore, every German household is required by law to pay the so-called "GEZ Gebühr" (television license). In almost all cases, Erasmus students are required to contribute to the household television license:
